SCHOLARSHIP & FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Merit Scholarships:

Merit based scholarship is awarded to the students as an acknowledgement of their smart work during their college life. These scholarships are announced one month after the declaration of Intermediate results. Students deposit their tuition fee in two installments. One at the time of admission and second after two months. Students who qualify for Merit Scholarship get their fee adjustments in the second fee voucher. The Schedule of Merit Based Scholarship is as follows:

1. Scholarships for BS Studies on the basis of FA/FSC/etc. (BISE Examinations)

3. Kinship Policy:

The Kin of Alumni/ae and existing students (brother, sister, husband, wife, father, mother, son and daughter) are allowed 10% tuition fee waiver.

4. Rules Governing Financial Awards and Scholarships

- All kinds of financial aid and scholarships shall be permanently withdrawn on tuition fee default of two
 consecutive semesters.
- If student getting scholarship or financial assistance discontinues his/her studies for two consecutive semesters and would like to resume his/her studies later shall be treated as a new applicant for admission and all fee, awards, rights and privileges shall be allowed accordingly.
- If student getting scholarship or financial assistance leaves the program/University before completion
 of his/her degree, total fee will be charged, without any discount/waiver, at the time of clearance before
 issuance of transcript and NOC.
- In case of any disciplinary breach, involvement in activities political, unethical, and/or against the
 interest(s) of the University or its authorities shall be liable to disciplinary action and shall result in
 withdrawal of all financial awards, discounts, privileges', whatsoever.
- For merit scholarship: If the student gets 3 'F' grades in Bachelors, 2 'F' in Masters and 1 'F' in PhD program, his/her financial assistance will be reverted irrevocably.
- If student getting scholarship or financial assistance repeats a course, the student shall be charged with the full fee for the repeat of course.

5. Work Based Scholarships:

University of South Asia has introduced a unique Scholarship Program to provide financial support to the students who cannot afford the cost of higher education. This program is called Work Based Scholarship. As the name suggest, it is an option provided to all the students besides DPT, Law and Architecture programs to apply for 30% to 90% fee assistance for which they work for 10 to 30 hours per week. The work will be related to the education of students providing them great opportunity to gain hands on work experience and they will be asked to work from office, home or online. University will determine the abilities of students and provide them training accordingly and they will work on projects after completing the training sessions.

The Schedule of Work Based Scholarship is as Follows:

- 1. 30% Scholarship: 10 Hours Work
- 2. 45% Scholarship: 15 Hours Work
- 3. 60% Scholarship: 20 Hours Work

- 4. 75% Scholarship: 25 Hours Work
- 5. 90% Scholarship: 30 Hours Work
